CALL TO ORDER

Chairwoman Mosbacher called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.

DIRECTOR'S UPDATE

1) Election Update

Director D'Itri informed the Board that Mount Bethel 04 would remain open until 7:35 p.m. due to a delayed opening. He also noted that at time of polls close today, a couple of precincts still had voters waiting in line.

Director D'Itri informed the Board that a new apartment complex within the city limits of Kennesaw had three street segments incorrectly coded as unincorporated in the voter registration system. Before the error was corrected, which affected 82 voters, 7 of those voters had already cast ballots that did not include the Kennesaw municipal contests. The office was able to contact 6 of those voters, as well as leave a message for a family member of the 7th voter. At the time of the Board meeting, 4 of the contacted voters had cast provisional ballots for the Kennesaw municipal contests.

Director D'Itri also addressed the issues that arose at Thompson Community Center throughout Election Day and shared that the office will conduct a full after-action meeting to determine corrective measures and improve the voting process.

A discussion followed regarding how the appropriate amount of equipment is allocated to each polling location. The board also considered issuing a public statement regarding Election Day operations.
