Election Day: GARViS voter credit reflects a discrepancy of one due to a poll pad glitch involving a voter check in at Vinings 02.

Advance Voting: The discrepancy between ballots cast and voter credit was due to a voter checking in and voting, but was not able to receive credit in GARViS as they are still pending in the system.

Absentee by Mail: The two discrepancies include one ballot that is provisional; it has been accepted in the system but will be cast, and the results downloaded at end of business day on Friday, November 7. Another discrepancy involves a voter whose ballot that was accepted in GARViS, but the ballot could not be scanned due to the top and bottom sections of the ballot containing the precinct information were missing.

Ms. Efrat inquired about the requirements for a recount given the close Mayoral contest in Marietta. Director D'Itri stated a candidate may request a recount within two days after certification if the margin between the two candidates is less than 0.50%.

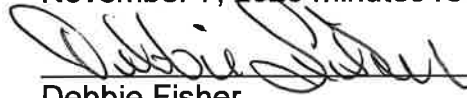
