CALL TO ORDER

Chairwoman Mosbacher called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.

Director D'Itri reported that there is an Absentee by Mail ballot that was rejected due to a missing driver's license number on the oath envelope. The voter has until Friday, November 21 at 5:00 p.m. to cure the ballot.

Smyrna 4A was the busiest polling location of the day, serving over 400 voters. Thompson Community Center, our Smyrna 7A precinct and the location that experienced some logistical issues during the last election, had 51 eligible voters for this election; four voted in advance and three voted on Election Day.

The only complaint received during Election Day involved campaign signs reportedly being removed at three precinct locations. After checking with the poll workers, it was confirmed that all signs were placed outside the 150 ft boundary where poll workers are not involved with campaign signage.

Chairwoman Mosbacher noted that the Secretary of State's GA My Voter Page was down for part of the morning. Director D'Itri explained that a Cloudflare network issue that affected the Secretary of State's website but did not result in an increase in calls to the office. The issue caused intermittent problems logging into GARViS, but service was restored within a few hours.

Chairwoman Mosbacher also stated that Ms. Fisher petitioned the State Election Board for a waiver for the next three pre-certification meetings. The next meeting will be the Certification of the Special Election for Senate District 35 on Monday, November 21 at 4:00 p.m.

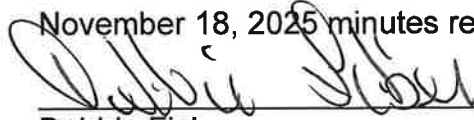
