CALL TO ORDER

Chairwoman Mosbacher called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

- Election Day: There was one additional voter check-in compared to ballots cast. The most likely explanation is that a voter left the precinct with their ballot.
- Advance Voting: There was a discrepancy of two between voter credit and ballots cast. One discrepancy is due to a voter whose status remains pending in the registration system until the current Municipal Election is closed, though the voter registered in time. Once his status becomes active, his participation credit will be updated. The second discrepancy, after research, has been isolated to a specific day and hour, and while it cannot be confirmed, it may have resulted from a ballot being scanned a second time following a scanner jam.
- Absentee by Mail: A total of 41 ballots were cast. One additional ballot was returned without the required driver's license information. The voter had until 5 p.m. on Friday, November 21 to cure the issue but did not do so, and the ballot remained rejected.
- Provisional: There were 2 provisional ballots cast. Five ballots were returned on Election Day. One voter was required to provide identification by 5 p.m. on Friday, November 21 but did not meet the deadline. Of the remaining ballots, 2 were determined to be ineligible. One voter was registered in Fulton County, and the second had already cast a ballot.

Motion by Ms. Fisher to certify the November 18, 2025, Special Election for Senate District 35. Second by Ms. Efrat. Motion Passed 3-0. Mr. Turner and Ms. Watkins were not in attendance.

PUBLIC HEARING

Director D'Itri requested a temporary polling location change for Smyrna 2A from First Baptist Church in Smyrna to the Smyrna Community Center for the December 16 Special Election Runoff for Senate District 35. The temporary location is 0.3 miles from the original site. This request is a temporary relocation, rather than a co-location.

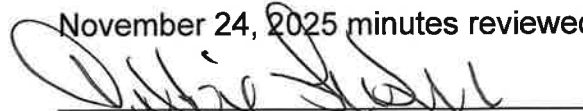
