CALL TO ORDER

Chairwoman Mosbacher called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Chairwoman Mosbacher proposed an amendment to the agenda to add an item to new business for the discussion of the recount of the Public Service Commission (PSC) District 3 Republican Primary with the potential for a special called meeting to recertify the results.

Motion by Ms. Efrat to amend the agenda to add the proposed item of new business. Second by Ms. Watkins. Motion Passed 5-0.

Motion by Ms. Watkins to approve the agenda as amended. Second by Ms. Efrat. Motion Passed 5-0.

Interim Director D'Itri stated that the discrepancy between the GARViS Voter Credit and the Ballots Cast for both Election Day and Advance Voting is due to Vote Safe and Supplemental Voters.

2) Certification of the June 16, 2026 General Primary Election Runoff

Motion by Ms. Efrat to certify the results of the June 16, 2026 General Primary Election Runoff. Second by Ms. Watkins. Motion Passed 5-0.

OLD BUSINESS

There were no items of Old Business.

NEW BUSINESS**1) Proposed "I Voted" Sticker Design Contest**

Ms. Watkins suggested postponing the discussion of the proposed "I Voted" sticker design contest to the July 2026 Board meeting pending budget review by the office.

Motion by Ms. Watkins to postpone the discussion of the proposed "I Voted" sticker design contest until the July 2026 regular Board Meeting. Second by Mr. Turner. Motion Passed 5-0.

2) Discussion of Recount of the PSC District 3 Republican Primary Contest and the Potential for a Special Called Meeting to Recertify the Results

Mr. White shared that a statewide recount was ordered for the District 3 PSC Republican Primary because the margin between the candidates was less than 0.5 percent. Fitz Johnson received 50.1 percent of the vote, while Brandon Martin received 49.8 percent. Under state law, Mr. Martin was entitled to request a recount, and the Secretary of State directed county election superintendents to conduct the recount.

Interim Director D'Itri stated that if the recount results differed from the original certified results for the contest, the results would need to be recertified.

Motion by Mr. Turner to approve a Special Called Meeting on Friday, June 26 at 3:00 p.m. for the potential recertification of the PSC District 3 Republican Primary. Second by Ms. Fisher.

Motion Passed 5-0.

BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

Mr. Turner expressed concern regarding staffing shortages on Election Day, and the need for a budget review for voter education and outreach.

Ms. Fisher shared her opposition to the continued use of QR codes to tabulate votes in Georgia elections and expressed her disappointment in elected officials who have chosen to ignore the clear will of Republican voters.

Chairwoman Mosbacher expressed her appreciation to the election staff for their efforts in the June 16, 2026 General Primary Runoff.

Mr. White informed the Board there was no need for Executive Session.

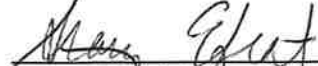
